




As a minimum, should the WSC offer a Basic Pistol/Home Firearms Saftey Course to its members on a regular basis?






Instructors both within and outside the club put a lot of time and effort into teaching courses. Are you willing to pay for these classes? If YES, how much (for say, a one day class)?


If the class is open to the General Public, should the General Public pay the same as WSC members?
