REQUEST FOR INDOOR RANGE ACCESS

Read the Rules and Regulations below. Sign the bottom and return to Indoor Range Chairman before or on day of your Guns Skills Safety Review (GSSR) briefing.

- **ALWAYS** remember to sign the logbook prior to entering the range – note ALL calibers that you used and if you brought a guest. If you failed to sign in, you will be contacted. After two instances of failing to sign the logbook, your range privileges will be revoked and you will have to come before the E Board to have your access reinstated.
- **NEVER** let other members “piggy back” at the same time you enter the range. If another shooter arrives to shoot, make sure they swipe their proximity card/fob. If damage was done to the range and you are the only one logged-in, you will be responsible.
- **ONLY** use allowed target ammunition. These calibers are posted at each shooting station in the indoor range. Center-fire ammo must not exceed 1300 f.p.s (feet per second). **At NO TIME** should you use steel BB's, MAGNUM handgun cartridges or center-fire rifle cartridges (e.g., .223, .30 carbine, .30-30 and .45-70) even when fired from a handgun (e.g.: Thompson Contender). The only rifle allowed in the Indoor Range are those chambered in .22 LR rimfire.
- Only **PAPER** targets are allowed in the Indoor Range. Maximum size of a paper target is 14” x 14”, no full size silhouettes or targets that hang down past the lower retaining wall.
- All targets must be placed in the target carrier system and “cranked” all the way down the range until it reaches the backstop. At no time may a target be “cranked” to a shorter distance (e.g.: halfway down range)
- All shooters must stand behind the benches at the stations. Shooting is not allowed from a position down range.
- The Indoor Range **is not** a place to train shooters. Please use the Outdoor Range for “new-to-shooting” training.
- Clean up all empty shell casings and dispose of any brass shells in the container provided. A dust pan and broom are provided.
- When finished using the Indoor Range, make sure the range lights and exhaust fan is shut off, and the range door locks behind you.
- **The Indoor Range security video is reviewed weekly.** If your use of the Indoor Range is deemed to be unsafe and/or you are unable to consistently hit the backstop with your shots, you will be contacted and not allowed to use the Indoor Range until cleared by one of the club Certified Pistol Instructors.

Prior to being issued access to use the range, you will need to attend a Gun Safety Skills Review briefing. GSSR Briefings are scheduled on the WSC website Calendar. Please check the date and time of the briefing that fits your schedule and bring the appropriate gun, safety equipment, and ammo. None of these are provided.
